ORDER

As a matter of fact, Haryana Medical Services Corporation Ltd Panchkula (HMSCL) had awarded a Rate Contract (RC) to M/S Devansh Testing and Research Lab. Ltd. 94 Shiv Ganga, Industrial Estate, Lakeshari Bhagawanpur, Roorkee Distt. Haridawar (UK)(hereafter called as the firm) vide Memo No. RC-16/MMC/HMSCL/3/4-A-234/8952 dated 14.12.2016.

It would be significant to mention here that the firm was awarded rate contract for the empanelment for analysis of drugs. The firm was informed in detail vide memo No HMSCL/2017/ 10454 dated 06-12-2017 that the samples of Paracetamol Pediatric Oral Suspension i.e. batch No S-2121,2134,2142, 2149 and calcium & Vitamin D-3 tablet Batch No. CUTT-93 were sent for testing and the same were declared of "Standard Quality" by the firm. Pertinently, random sampling of the same drug of the same batches was conducted by the DCOs of FDA/ State Drug Controller, Haryana and same has been found to be "Not of Standard Quality" by Government Analyst, Haryana.

Thereafter, the firm was served with a show cause notice vide this office memo no ¾-A- (T&IT)/HMSCL/2018/3332 dated 09-05-2018 in detail regarding the fact that testing report by Government Analyst, Haryana has been found to be "Not of Standard Quality". Subsequently, firm submitted the reply of aforesaid show cause notice vide their letter DTRL/LTR/2018-227 dated 18.5.2018 with the intimation that samples are highly sensitive for proper storage condition as to avoid stability issues and performing of test for specific after well shaking before sampling to avoid uniformity salt, may be settled down and due to colour amber of bottles and less visibility sample not proper taken or stability due to improper storage, however reply has not been found satisfactory.

In view of the variations found in test reports by the empanelled lab and Government Analyst, Haryana, in 4 batches of samples of Paracetamol Pediatric Oral Suspension i.e. batch No S-2121,2134,2142, 2149 and one batch of sample of Calcium with vitamin D-3 tablet batch No. CUTT-93 with respect to assay and

description, it is quite evident that proper testing was not done by the firm and hence, firm has violated Para no-6 of the Rate contract, since there are more than three instances in assay test and four instances other than assay in a year. Hence, as per the Clause No. 6 of the terms and conditions of the RC, the rate contract No. RC-16/MMC/HMSCL/3/4-A-225/8952 dated 14.12.16 awarded to the firm is hereby terminated with immediate effect and the firm (service provider) is also blacklisted for a period of 5 (five) years and resultantly, performance bank guarantee is forfeited.

This order would be without any prejudice to legal and criminal action which is required to be taken, if any, by HMSCL in the matter.
