Order

Whereas, Haryana Medical Services Corporation Ltd., Panchkula had published the tenders through e-procurement system on 3.4.2017 for arranging rate contract for two years of medicines of Group-A and Group-B.

Whereas, M/s Synokem Pharmaceuticals Ltd. (here after called as the firm) had participated for one medicine in Group-A and three medicines in Group-B. The firm had submitted an affidavit dated 21.4.2017 in Group-B affidavit dated 25.4.2017 in Group-A that the firm had not been blacklisted/ debarred either by tender inviting authority or by any state Govt. or Central Govt. Organization for the products quoted in the tender.

Whereas, the firm was debarred by Jammu & Kashmir Medical Supplies Corporation Ltd. (JKMSCL) vide order no. 830 of 2017 dated: 14.1.2017 for participating in any of the tendering/e-bidding process of JKMSCL on the ground of non execution of supply orders for a period of two years. Hence the firm was debarred by JKMSCL at the time of filing of tender and submission of affidavit for all items.

Whereas, a show cause notice vide this office memo no. 3/4-A-170(T&IT)/HMSCL/2017/6764 dated: 5.7.2017 was issued to the firm on account of submission of fraudulent affidavit. The firm had replied in response there to that the firm had requested to JKMSCL for revoking of order no. 830/2017 dated: 16.1.2017 and further stated that they had submitted the affidavits dated: 25.4.2017 & 21.4.2017 as per the draft in Annexure-8.7 in the tender documents of HMSCL regarding supply of spurious drug to any purchasing authority. The reply submitted by the firm was not satisfactory and the firm was given personal hearing on 24.10.2017.

Whereas, Mr. Neeraj Tyagi Sales Manager Institutional sale Synokem Pharmaceutical Ltd appeared for personal hearing on dated: 24.10.2017. The firm submitted representation in lieu of personal hearing on dated: 25.10.2017 stating that affidavit regarding debarring/blacklisting, which was suggested by tender inviting authority was wrongly interpreted, inadvertently the firm filled the incorrect affidavit at the time of filling of the tender.



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Therefore, being a case of submission of false affidavit, Bid Security of the firm amounting to Rs. 50,000/- of Group-A medicines & Rs. 1,50,000 of Group-B medicines is forfeited and the firm is debarred to participate in the tenders of HMSCL for a period of three years from the date of issuance of this letter as per terms & conditions of DNIT clause no. 7.16.3.

This order is without prejudice to legal and criminal action to be taken, if any, by HMSCL in the matter.
